Scholarship recipients will be required to audition and/or work on a technical assignment for each production during the semester and be enrolled in at least one theatre course along with Theatre Practice I and II and meet the requirements printed on the back of this form.

## Theatre Department Scholarship Requirements

Types of scholarships offered by the Theatre Department:

### TCC Performance Emphasis Scholarship

- Amount: Varies. \$250, \$500, \$750, \$1000
- Recipients must be high school students who are pursuing studies in the Theatre Program as a Theatre major. Recipients must be legal residents of the state of Oklahoma. Minimum GPA of 2.5 for first semester students, and 3.0 for second semester.

### TCC Technical Emphasis Scholarship

- Amount: Varies. \$250, \$500, \$750, \$1000 (Freshmen cannot exceed \$250 for first semester scholarship) Each Tuition waiver is ONLY awarded per semester and students work will be reviewed before renewal. Waiver amounts can be increased through participation in the theatre program.
- Recipients must be high school students who are pursuing studies in the Theatre Program as a Theatre major. Recipients must be legal residents of the state of Oklahoma. Minimum GPA of 2.5 for first semester students, and 3.0 for second semester.

- **Tuition Waiver**

**This scholarship waives tuition for up to 9 credit hours. It does not include textbooks, parking, ID or other student fees. Financial Services is notified of the successful applicants and they then credit the student's account with the number of hours granted in the waiver. If a student has already paid for the upcoming academic period's classes, then Financial Services will send the student a refund reflecting the scholarship portion of the paid tuition.**

#### **Requirements for Tuition Waiver:**

1. Current High School or College cumulative **grade point average of 2.75 or above.**
2. Enrollment in a minimum of **twelve hours of coursework.**
3. Participate in Theatre per semester. (Performance, Design, tech, etc.....) **Must work on both theatrical productions per semester (Performer or technician).**
4. Audition/Interview (this may be waived for prior students whose ability is already known to the faculty).
5. Student must be an Oklahoma resident and a **theatre major** to receive a theatre scholarship.
6. Student must enroll each semester in **Theatre Practice I or II** and another 3-credit theatre course.
7. All theatre scholarships awarded are **PENDING** and final approval must be given by the Financial Aid Department.
8. Every theatre scholarship student is subject to a review each semester and not always automatically renewed. (**Attitude, not attending class or behavior issues will result in forfeit of tuition waiver.**)

Students will be notified by letter if they receive a tuition waiver prior to the beginning of the applicable semester. **Students must return** the notification letter prior to the deadline to acknowledge their acceptance or denial of the scholarship offered or it may be revoked.
