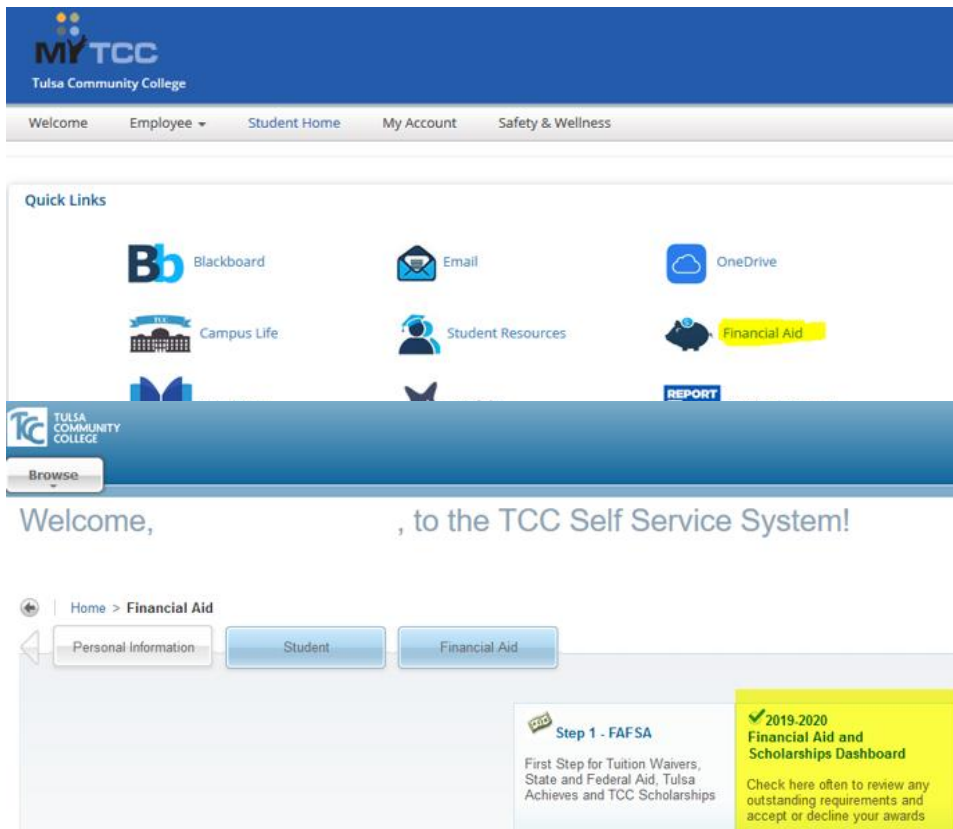


1. **ACCESS** the financial aid Dashboard in MYTCC. Click on the Piggy Bank, then on the 2019-2020 Financial Aid and Scholarships Dashboard.



2. **READ** the instructions in the Welcome Message.

Welcome to the TCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Dashboard. You are currently classified as a high school concurrent student. This Dashboard contains important information regarding your Attend College Early (ACE) tuition waiver. To accept your tuition waiver, please review your holds, missing requirements, and Terms and Conditions which are linked below this message. Once you've read and accepted your terms and conditions, you can accept your tuition waiver on your dashboard.

Communication: In addition to posting information here, TCC communicates with students through their TCC email. For privacy reasons this is the only email TCC Financial Aid uses to communicate with students. It is important you routinely check your TCC email for any messages from Financial Aid.

3. **CHECK** for important Financial Aid, Student, and Bursar messages and holds.

Senior Concurrent Waiver	The amount offered for the Attend College Early (ACE) Tuition Waiver is estimated. Actual payments are dependent on hours enrolled and annual award limits. Once your award is accepted your tuition waiver may be re-calculated based on your individual eligibility. Senior concurrent students can receive up to 18 hours of tuition waiver payments during their senior year. Hours enrolled in excess of the annual 18 hour maximum will not be paid for by a tuition waiver.

6. **VIEW** your Award Package: You cannot view the awards until you have accepted the Terms and Conditions. The waiver(s) will be applied to your Bursar account after the third week of the semester. You may check your TCC email and your Dashboard for updates. To pay the remaining balance (fees, books, etc...) you may either pay online or go to any TCC campus Bursar office.

7. **KNOW** the annual award limit information. Seniors may track the number of hours remaining in the aid year.

Annual Award Limit Information

Including this semester's enrollment, you have **18** hours remaining of your 18 hour annual limit. Concurrent seniors cannot receive more 18 hours of tuition waiver payments during their senior year of high school.

8. **CHECK** your Academic Progress. This section is strictly informational, but it provides a link to Academic Progress, so you can be aware of your Satisfactory Academic Progress prior to entering as college freshman.

Academic Progress

- **Academic Progress** is a measure of how financial aid students are performing in their courses. As a current high school student, your **Academic Progress** will not affect your ability to receive the ACE tuition waiver; however, it may impact your future eligibility for other types of aid such as Pell Grant, Tulsa Achieves, Oklahoma's Promise, student loans, and more. It is advisable that you track your academic progress as it will affect your TCC career after you graduate high school.
